2021

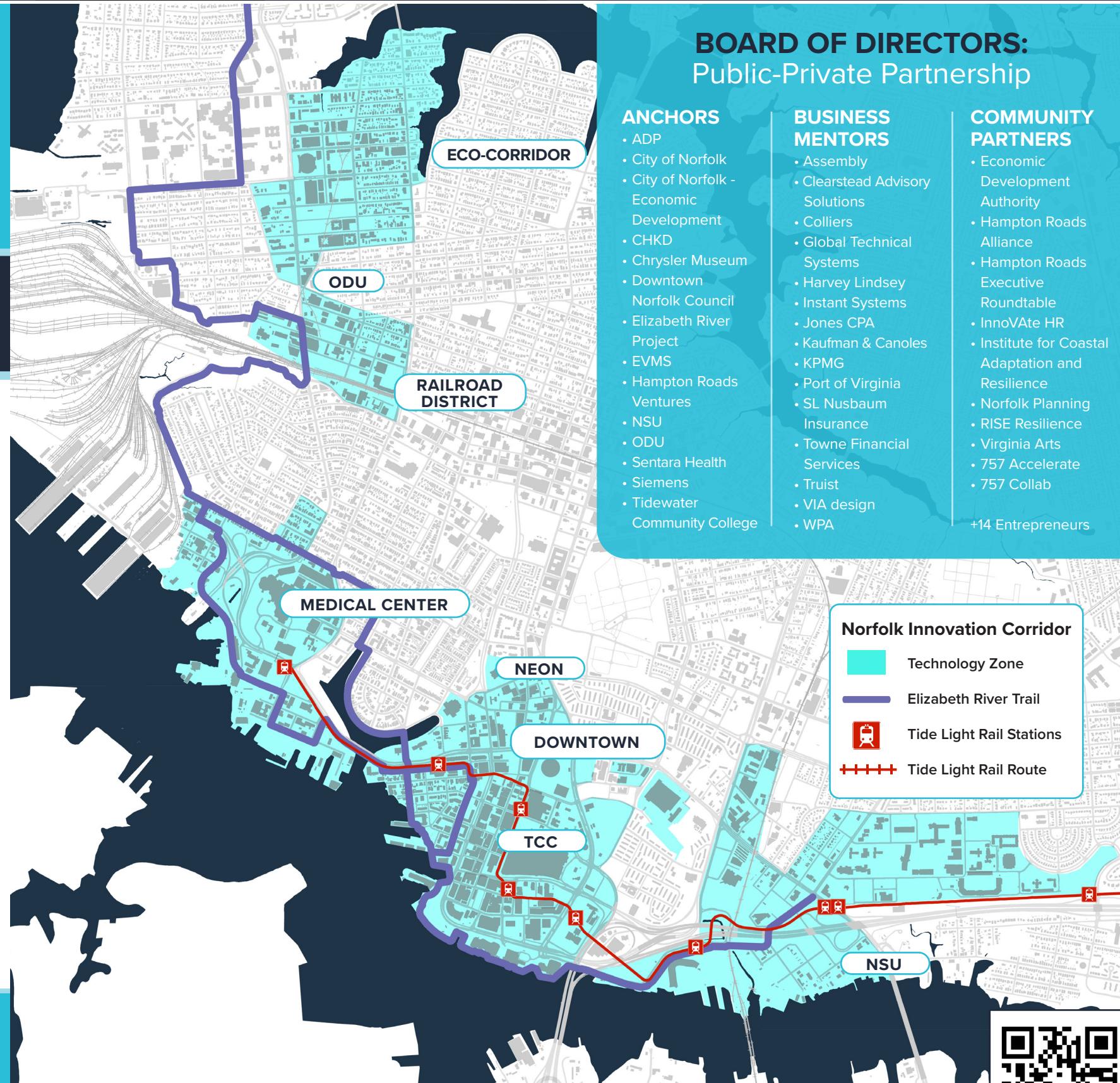
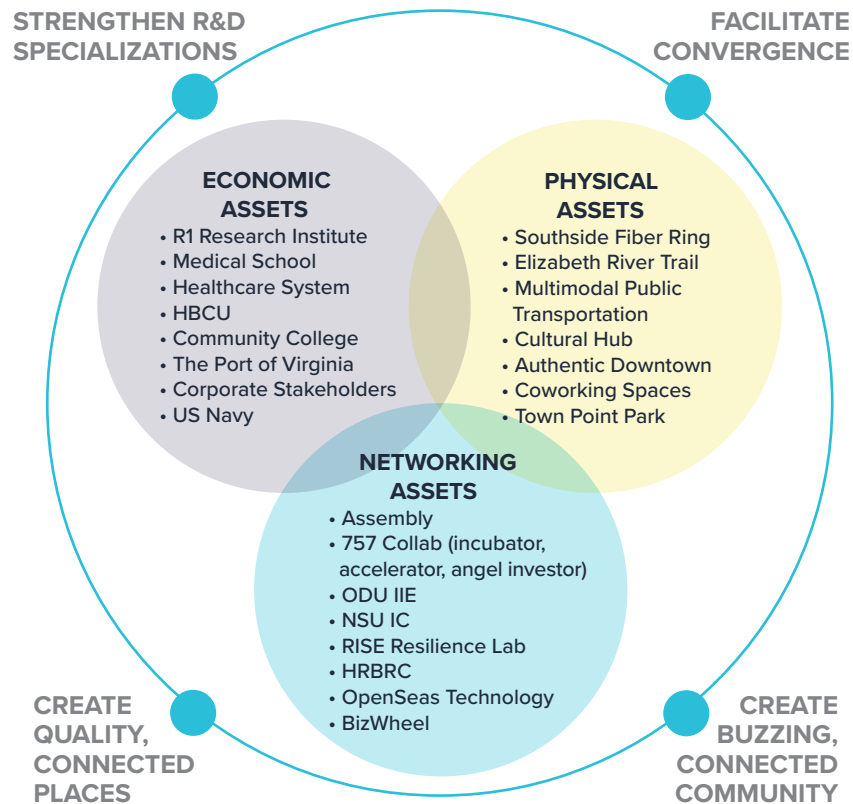
